RESOLUTION #15 - 03

"SUPPORT FOR THE T3 TRIBAL TECHNOLOGY TRAINING PROGRAM"

PREAMBLE

We, the members of the Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indians of the United States, invoking the divine blessing of the Creator upon our efforts and purposes, in order to preserve for ourselves and our descendants rights secured under Indian Treaties, Executive Orders, and benefits to which we are entitled under the laws and constitution of the United States and several states, to enlighten the public toward a better understanding of the Indian people, to preserve Indian cultural values, and otherwise to promote the welfare of the Indian people, do hereby establish and submit the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indians (ATNI) are representatives of and advocates for national, regional, and specific tribal concerns; and

WHEREAS, ATNI is a regional organization comprised of American Indians/Alaska Natives and tribes in the states of Washington, Idaho, Oregon, Montana, Nevada, Northern California, and Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the health, safety, welfare, education, economic and employment opportunity, and preservation of cultural and natural resources are primary goals and objectives of the ATNI; and

WHEREAS, the ATNI Telecommunications Committee has been working hard to address the lack of access to tribal technology training funds and opportunity in rural native communities; and


WHEREAS, the Washington State Broadband Office found that the communities surveyed expressed the need, interest and motivation to participate in Tribally led technology training program; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that ATNI supports the development of the T3 Training Program that will help build the individual and organizational capacity of Tribal technology; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indians support the efforts of the T3 partnership to raise and leverage resources to develop and implement technology training to northwest tribal communities.
